Courtney update- It is the afternoon of Pentecost. We gather on folding chairs crammed into a small kitchen. Parents sent young kids to the counter to fetch some cheese and crackers. Meanwhile, dogs scoot underfoot. Beautiful flowers adorn the small room and fill it with fragrance. An urn sits on a coffee table, and prayer flags hang from the ceiling. Early 90s power ballads play from the living room. Over the next hour, a seven-year-old talks about her good uncle. Boys share about the epic YouTube videos their uncle made. A young man plays a song on his guitar that his uncle taught him. A woman



speaks of the love of her life. At some point, someone started passing out paper towels that hung on a rod attached to the fridge to wipe away their tears. [Read More](#)
