Advocates are everyday Missoulians who want to help people who are experiencing homelessness & support them after they obtain housing.

****Email marilyn@micmt.org to sign up.** Orientations occurs monthly at St. Paul's Church in the Fellowship Hall. The following orientation is June 5.**

1. Attend an orientation.
2. Commitment of 2-3 hours a week.
3. Attend monthly meetings.
4. Work one-on-one with an individual seeking housing.

Did you know?

-About half the homeless population are employed.

-About 15 percent are chronically homeless, while 67% have been homeless for less than a year.

-The number of homeless and at-risk children in the Missoula County Public Schools increased by 16.38% in the 2014-2015 school year.

MIGHTY OAK FOUNDATION

The Mighty Oak Foundation is a faith-based Veteran service organization that teaches combat Veterans struggling with Post Traumatic Stress how to get beyond combat trauma and live their lives. Their work strengthens Veterans, their marriages, and their families.



The main program is their Legacy Program, a six-day peer to peer event at one of their lodge locations throughout the US (they have followup relationships after this event as well). There is both a men's and women's Legacy Program. While the program itself is free to Vets, the travel costs to the lodges can be prohibitive. As a result the Gianforte Family Foundation is offering scholarships to cover the travel costs of Montana vets who want to participate.

In addition, you can visit the Mighty Oaks website and learn about other ways to promote the program yourselves, such as bringing in a speaker to an event or church service. Their main goal is to get the word out in Montana about this chance for growth and healing for Montana's struggling Veterans.
