

- 1. Attend an orientation.
- 2. Commitment of 2-3 hours a week.
- 3. Attend monthly meetings.
- 4. Work one-on-one with an individual seeking housing.

Did you know?

- -About half the homeless population are employed.
- -About 15 percent are chronically homeless, while 67% have been homeless for less than a year.
- -The number of homeless and at-risk children in the Missoula County Public Schools increased by 16.38% in the 2014-2015 school year.


