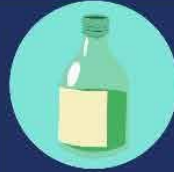

- About half the homeless population are employed.
- About 15 percent are chronically homeless, while 67% have been homeless for less than a year.
- The number of homeless and at-risk children in the Missoula County Public Schools increased by 16.38% in the 2014-2015 school year.
